- The Gospel calls us forth to *full responsibility for our emotional life*.
- Our *basic core of goodness* is our true Self.
- *Transforming union* develops into a permanent state through a *restructuring of consciousness*.
- Envisage the divine energy as infinite potentiality.
- We feel that our prayer is not just a privatized journey but is having a *significant effect* in the world.
